Town of Mooresville's Collection Tips for Yard Debris

This is a condensed excerpt from the Mooresville "Town Voice" newsletter (Sept. 2019) regarding pickup of leftover gardening material and yard debris.

Please keep limbs about six feet long, and facing the same direction when you put them near the curb. It helps town employees who are loading them in their truck's rear loader manually.

If you have a larger pile of limbs, the brush crew will have to return with a special truck, and they will notify you and come back within three to five days to pick up the pile. Leaves and grass clippings are picked up by a vacuum truck; so, leave them in a loose pile and un-bagged. (The vacuum truck normally visits Water Oak the day after trash/recycle pickup.)

The Sanitation Department will not collect mulch, dirt, or rocks. Additionally, **if you have used a contracted service like a landscaper, the hired company must haul away their debris**.
